Pre- and post-operative photos can be included in the video. It must not contain any commercially appealing content or background music.

The recommended size for each video is 10-100MB, with a maximum size of 200MB. Accepted formats are: MOV, MPEG4, AVI, WMV. Videos must not have been published or submitted to other electronic journals in the future.
